


First Lesson: Revelation 7:9-17 L: Word of God, Word of Life. **C: Thanks be to God.**

Holy Communion


Christ invites us all and wants you to be included.




Those wishing to be included without having the bread and wine may come forward for a blessing. Please indicate this by folding your arms. *All wafers and bread are gluten free.
